

EASTRIDGE LITTLE LEAGUE 2008 SEASON **LITTLE LEAGUE RULES**

All managers, coaches, parents, relatives and umpires:

1. Must read little league rule book to acquire knowledge about the games conduct and all phases. This may take more than one reading. The key is to read the rule book and not ignore the directive.
2. Seek information from the Eastridge Little League board and player agents for clarification of rules not understood.
3. In each division from each team one should attend umpire clinics conducted by District 59 umpire in chief.
4. Visit the Little league website for rule changes and interpretations.
5. Carry the Little league rule book at all times, games, and practices so that it becomes a constant companion at Little League functions and used as a initial source in definitions, descriptions, and interpretations of game conduct.
6. Must enforce Little league rules at games and practices including proper equipment.
7. Must sign “volunteer code of conduct contract” and strictly observe “sport parent code of conduct” at all times.
8. In 7 and 8 managers/coaches and parents must know that if rules are violated that suspension,

season forfeiture of the privilege of attending all games that may occur.

Rule 13 Safety

This is supplemental to enforce little league rules including proper equipment and should be strictly observed during the 2008 season.

- 1. Follow Little League Rules that have some basis for safety.**
- 2. Players must have required equipment at all times, and includes, catchers warming up during infield and outfield practice and game situations.**
- 3. Managers and Coaches must enforce these rules at practices and games.**
- 4. Managers and Coaches are not permitted to catch pitchers (Rule 3.09); this includes standing at backstop during practice as informal catcher for batting practice.**
